Thermodynamics: An Engineering Approach Thermodynamic heat pump cycles or refrigeration cycles are the conceptual and mathematical models for heat pump, air conditioning and refrigeration systems. the ASHRAE Handbook, ASHRAE, Incorporated, Atlanta, Georgia, 2004. Thus a heat pump may be thought of as a "heater" if the objective is to warm the heat sink (as when warming the inside of a home on a cold day), or a "refrigerator" or "cooler" if the objective is to cool the heat source (as in the normal operation of a freezer). The operating principles in both cases are the same; energy is used to move heat from a

Thermal management (electronics) McGraw All electronic devices and circuitry generate excess heat and thus require thermal management to improve reliability and prevent premature failure. In cases of extreme low environmental temperatures, it may actually be necessary to heat the electronic components to achieve satisfactory operation.
