Hilbert's problems The complete list of 23 problems was published later, in English translation in 1902 by Mary Frances Winston Newson in the Bulletin of the American Mathematical Society. Hilbert presented ten of the problems (1, 2, 6, 7, 8, 13, 16, 19, 21, and 22) at the Paris conference of the International Congress of Mathematicians, speaking on August 8 at the Sorbonne. Earlier publications (in the original German) appeared in Archiv der Mathematik und Physik. Paul Cohen received the Fields Medal in 1966 for his work on the first problem, and the negative solution of the tenth Hilbert's problems are 23 problems in mathematics published by German mathematician David Hilbert in 1900. Attributed to American philosopher Edmund Gettier, Gettier-type counterexamples (called "Gettier-cases") challenge the long-held justified true belief (JTB) account of knowledge. The JTB account holds that knowledge is equivalent to justified true belief; if all three conditions (justification, truth, and belief) are met of a given claim, then there is knowledge of that claim. In his 1963 three-page paper titled "Is Justified True Belief Knowledge" (1963), Gettier argued that the JTB account is insufficient to guarantee knowledge. He provided two counterexamples, now known as "Gettier cases," which show that it is possible to have justified true belief without having knowledge.
