The thing In the sciences and in historiography, denialism is the rejection of basic facts and concepts that are undisputed, well-supported parts of the scientific consensus or historical record on a subject, in favor of ideas that are radical, controversial, or fabricated. Deception of the truth. It is often done for personal gain or advantage. Untruths: misinterpreting the truth. The person creating the deception knows it to be false while the receiver of the information does not. Buller and Burgoon (1996) have proposed three taxonomies to distinguish motivations for deception based on the receiver's perception of the truth. Deception is the act of convincing one or many recipients of untrue information (Buller & Burgoon, 1996).

Historical negationism "Deception includes falsifying information, obscuring the truth, and lying to manipulate public opinion about the historical event discussed in the revised Historical negationism, also called historical denialism, is the falsification, trivialization, or distortion of the historical record. This is distinct from historical revisionism, a broader term encompassing academic reinterpretations of history driven by new evidence or reasoning. In attempting to revise and influence the past, historical negationism acts as illegitimate historical revisionism by using techniques inadmissible in proper historical discourse, such as presenting known forged documents as genuine, inventing ingenious but implausible reasons for distrusting genuine documents, attributing conclusions to books and sources that report the opposite, manipulating statistical series to support the given point of view, and deliberately mistranslating traditional or modern texts (Keyes, 2004).

Post-truth Others Post-truth is a term that refers to the widespread documentation of, and concern about, disputes over public truth claims in the 21st century. argue that post-truth has similarities with past moral, epistemic, and political debates about relativism, postmodernity, and dishonesty in politics. ". The term's academic development refers to the theories and research that seek to explain the specific causes historically, and the effects of the phenomenon.
