Cooper's hawk It is easily confused with the smaller but similar sharp-shinned hawk. This species was formerly placed in the genus *Accipiter*. sufficiently forceful enough to drive away more formidable predators such as bobcats (*Lynx rufus*) from the nest area. (*Accipiter striatus*). As in many birds of prey, the male is smaller than the female. When large quadrupeds walk under the nest Cooper's hawk (*Astur cooperii*) is a medium-sized hawk native to the North American continent and found from southern Canada to Mexico.
