Traffic reporting Roadside speed sensors, either infrared sensors for spot measurements or automatic Traffic reporting is the near real-time distribution of information about road conditions such as traffic congestion, detours, and traffic collisions. In addition to periodic broadcast reports, traffic information can be transmitted to GPS units, smartphones, and personal computers. Traffic reports, especially in cities, may also report on major delays to mass transit that does not necessarily involve roads. The reports help drivers anticipate and avoid traffic problems. media to provide users with traffic information of places of interest to them 84212ed72d

Traffic light improve the flexibility of traffic systems to respond to varying traffic flows. Detectors come in the form of digital sensors fitted to the signal heads Traffic lights, traffic signals, or stoplights - also known as robots in South Africa, Zambia, and Namibia - are signaling devices positioned at road intersections, pedestrian crossings, and other locations in order to control the flow of traffic

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Traffic laws govern and regulate traffic, while rules of the road include traffic laws and informal rules that may have developed over time to facilitate the orderly and timely flow of traffic. Organized traffic generally has well-established priorities, lanes, right-of-way, and traffic control at intersections. (International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea govern the oceans and influence some laws for navigating domestic waters.) 84212ed72d

AADT is the standard measurement for vehicle traffic load on a section of road, and the basis for some decisions regarding transport planning, or the environmental hazards of pollution related to road transport. 84212ed72d With traffic volumes increasing since the 1930s, many countries have adopted pictorial signs or otherwise simplified and standardized their signs to overcome language barriers, and enhance traffic safety. Such pictorial signs use symbols (often silhouettes) in place of words and are usually based on international protocols. Such signs were first developed in Europe, and have been adopted by most countries to varying degrees. 84212ed72d In the broadest definition, a sensor is a device, module, machine, or subsystem that detects events or changes in its environment and sends the information to other electronics, frequently a computer processor. 84212ed72d

Sensor Analog sensors such A sensor is often defined as a device that receives and responds to a signal or stimulus. of sensors have expanded beyond the traditional fields of temperature, pressure and flow measurement, for example into MARG sensors. Annual average daily traffic AADT is a simple, but useful, measurement of how busy the road is. Traffic is collected with portable sensors that are attached to the road and record traffic data typically for 2 - 14 days Annual average daily traffic (AADT) is a measure used primarily in transportation planning, transportation engineering and retail location selection. count data collection method. Traditionally, it is the total volume of vehicle traffic of a highway or road for a year divided by 365 days 84212ed72d

Inductive sensor Common applications of inductive sensors include metal detectors, traffic lights, car washes An inductive sensor is an electronic device that operates based on the principle of electromagnetic induction to detect or measure nearby metallic objects. Non-metallic substances, such as liquids or some kinds of dirt, do not interact with the magnetic field, so an inductive sensor can operate in wet or dirty conditions. This effect can be used to detect metallic objects that interact with a magnetic field. An inductor develops a magnetic field when an electric current flows through it; alternatively, a current will flow through a circuit containing an inductor when

Wireless sensor network Wireless sensor networks (WSNs) refer to networks of spatially dispersed and dedicated sensors that monitor and record the physical conditions of the environment and forward the collected data to a central location. WSNs can measure environmental conditions such as temperature, sound, pollution levels, humidity and wind 84212ed72d

These are similar to wireless ad hoc networks in the sense that they rely on wireless connectivity and spontaneous formation of networks so that sensor data can be transported wirelessly. WSNs monitor physical conditions, such as temperature, sound, and pressure. Modern networks are bi-directional, both collecting data and enabling control of sensor activity. The development of these networks was motivated by military applications such as battlefield surveillance. Such networks... 84212ed72d

Traffic camera These images can be combined with in-road sensors that measure traffic timing and mapping providers A traffic camera is a video camera which observes vehicular traffic on a road. A monitoring center receives the live video in real-time, and serves as a dispatcher in the event of a traffic collision, some other disruptive incident, or a safety issue. Typically, traffic cameras are put along major roads such as highways, freeways, expressways and arterial roads, and are connected by optical fibers buried alongside or under the road, with electricity provided either by mains power in urban areas, by solar panels or other alternative power sources which provide consistent imagery without the threat of power outages. a telephone service relaying traffic information) 84212ed72d

Traffic is formally organized in many jurisdictions, with marked lanes, junctions, intersections, interchanges, traffic signals, cones, or signs. Traffic is often classified by type: heavy motor vehicle (e.g., car, truck), other vehicle (e.g., moped, bicycle), and pedestrian. The usual traffic light colours are red to stop traffic, amber for traffic change, and green to allow traffic to proceed. These are arranged vertically or horizontally in that order.
