More generally, if $x = by$, then y is the logarithm of x to base b , written $\log_b x$, so $\log_{10} 1000 = 3$. For example, the logarithm of 1000 to base 10 is 3, because 1000 is 10 to the 3rd power: $1000 = 10^3 = 10 \times 10 \times 10$. In primary school students A mathematical exercise is a routine application of algebra or other mathematics to a stated challenge. Mathematics teachers assign mathematical exercises to develop the skills of their students. Various approaches to geometry have based exercises on relations of angles, segments, and triangles. Extensive courses of exercises in school extend such arithmetic to rational numbers. Some texts, such as those in Schaum's Outlines, focus on worked examples rather than theoretical treatment of a mathematical topic.
