This overload of research papers makes it difficult for scientists. A review article is an article that summarizes the current state of understanding on a topic within a certain discipline. It resembles a survey article or, in news publishing, an overview article, which also surveys and summarizes previously published primary and secondary sources, instead of reporting new facts and results. A review article is generally considered a secondary source since it may analyze and discuss the method and conclusions in previously published studies.

Darwin's discovery was that the generation of life worked algorithmically, that processes behind it work in such a way that given these processes the results that they tend toward must be so. The crux of the argument is that, whether or not Darwin's theories are overturned, there is no going back from the dangerous idea that design (purpose or what something is for) might not need a designer.
