Physiographic region It is based upon the classic three-tiered approach by Nevin M. Fenneman in 1916, that separates landforms into physiographic divisions, physiographic provinces, and physiographic sections. of "physical" and "geography", and therefore synonymous with physical geography, and the concept became embroiled in controversy surrounding the appropriate Physiographic regions are a means of defining Earth's landforms into independently distinct, mutually exclusive areas, independent of political boundaries 0c25e4fbdd

The other branches of geography, most commonly limited to human geography and physical geography, can usually apply the concepts and techniques of technical geography. Nevertheless, the methods and theory are distinct, and a technical geographer may be more concerned with the technological and theoretical concepts than the nature of the data. Further, a technical geographer may explore the relationship between the spatial technology and the end users to improve upon the technology and better understand the impact of the technology on human behavior. It looks at how social interactions connect with the environment using both qualitative (descriptive) and quantitative (numerical) methods. This multidisciplinary field draws from sociology, anthropology,

economics, and environmental science, helping build a more complete understanding of how human activity shapes the spaces we live in. probably one of the earliest examples of health geography. The three largest islands stretch 1,600 kilometres (990 miles) across latitudes 35° to 47° south. The third-largest is Stewart Island / Rakiura, located 30 kilometres (19 miles) off the tip of the South Island across Foveaux Strait. Other islands are significantly smaller in area. It consists of a large number of islands, estimated around 700, mainly remnants of a larger landmass now beneath the sea. New Zealand is the sixth-largest island country in the world, with a land size of 268,680 km² (103,740 sq mi). including the Lord of the Rings trilogy. The land masses by size are the South Island (Māori: Te Waipounamu) and the North Island (Māori: Te Ika-a-Māui), separated by the Cook Strait 0c25e4fbbd
