This implies that the way that teacher educators teach their students Reflective practice is the ability to reflect on one's actions so as to take a critical stance or attitude towards one's own practice and that of one's peers, engaging in a process of continuous adaptation and learning. writers advocate for teacher educators themselves to act as models of reflective practice 2c000d2c51
