The School offers undergraduate, postgraduate and research degrees as well as CPD courses for those entering or working in health and care-related professions. Registered nurses are employed in a wide variety of professional settings, and often specialize in a field of practice. Depending on the jurisdiction, they may be responsible for supervising care delivered by other healthcare workers, including student nurses, licensed practical nurses, unlicensed assistive personnel, and less-experienced RNs.

Associate of Science in Nursing Some four-year colleges also offer this degree. Students awarded an Associate of Science in Nursing are qualified to sit for the NCLEX-RN and apply for licensure as a Registered Nurse. bachelor's degree, and there is no state exam on completion of the course. Midwives in the United States Today, midwives are professionals who must undergo formal training. United States formed the Midwifery Education, Regulation, and Association (US-MERA) task force to establish a framework for midwifery. Some midwives also provide primary care for women including well-woman exams, health promotion, and disease prevention, family planning options, and care for common gynecological concerns.
