design novel activity, behavior, or purpose, and to advance basic understanding of protein function. developed in David Baker's lab, was designed completely using protein design algorithms, to a completely novel fold. Rational protein design approaches make protein-sequence predictions that will fold to specific structures. Proteins can be designed from scratch (de novo design) or by making calculated variants of a known protein structure and its sequence (termed protein redesign). These predicted sequences can then be validated experimentally through methods such as peptide synthesis, site-directed mutagenesis, or artificial gene synthesis
