This article concentrates on the first generation Jaguar IRS, which firmly established the marque's reputation for suspension sophistication, combining as it did smooth ride with excellent roadholding and low levels of noise, vibration, and harshness (NVH). The Daimler Sovereigns were based on contemporary Jaguar bodysells, chassis and engines in an example of badge engineering.
