The goal of cultural competence in health care is to reduce health disparities and to provide optimal care to patients regardless of their race, gender, ethnic background, native language, and religious or cultural beliefs. This process includes consideration of the individual social, cultural, and psychological needs of patients for effective cross-cultural communication with their health care providers. Ethnocentrism is the belief that one's culture is better than others

Knowledge market An alternative model is based on treating knowledge as a public good and hence encouraging free sharing of knowledge. Currently

there is no consensus among researchers on relative merits of these two approaches. One view A knowledge market is a mechanism for distributing knowledge resources. One view uses a legal construct of intellectual property to make knowledge a typical scarce resource, so the traditional commodity market mechanism can be applied directly to distribute it.
