Limited political pluralism, which is achieved with constraints on the legislature, political parties and interest groups. The primary objective of the Just Transition Mechanism is to mitigate the worst socio-economic effects of the transition into a climate neutral economy, which can prove difficult for regions highly dependent on carbon-intensive industries. These areas usually count with lower GDP rates than the European average as well as certain degree of economic stagnation which makes them ever more vulnerable to the worst effects of the energy transition. This is particularly the case for coal mining communities, which lack employment opportunities beyond the sector. Kupers has written on complexity, resilience, energy transition, and climate change, examining their interdependencies to address challenges and develop policy approaches.
