These ideas rapidly disseminated through all social classes After 1870 school textbooks based on Confucianism were replaced by Westernized texts The history of education, like other history, extends at least as far back as the first written records recovered from ancient civilizations. In ancient India, education was mainly imparted through the Vedic and Buddhist learning system, while the first education system in ancient China was created in Xia dynasty (2070–1600 BC). For example, in Athens, during the 5th and 4th century BC, aside from two years military training, the state played little part in schooling. In the city-states of ancient Greece, most education was private, except in Sparta. The earliest known formal school was developed in Egypt's Middle Kingdom under the direction of Kheti, treasurer to Mentuhotep II (2061–2010 BC). Early Irish literature The early Irish literary tradition flourished through the Medieval Irish period, and its literary output showcases a blend of indigenous storytelling, myth, and historical narratives. By contrast, only one Early Irish literature, is commonly dated from the 8th or 9th to the 15th century, a period during which modern literature in Irish began to emerge. It stands as one of the oldest vernacular literature in Western Europe, with its roots extending back to late antiquity, as evident from inscriptions utilizing both Irish and Latin found on Ogham stones dating as early as the 4th century. Notably, this period saw the development of a full-scale vernacular written literature expressed in a diverse range of literary genres. fragments of the old metrical textbooks still exist, showing the courses required from the various grades of poets, in pre-Norse times bf7acd43ea
