Meaningful learning Since information is stored in a network of connections, it can be accessed from multiple starting points depending on the context of recall. It can include—but is not limited to—critical and creative thinking, inquiry, problem solving, critical discourse, and metacognitive skills. The learning material must clearly define the learning objective so learners will learn only what is important. Meaningful learning refers to the act of higher order thinking and development through intellectual engagement that uses pattern recognition and concept association. Meaningful learning is often contrasted with rote learning, a method in which information is memorized sometimes without elements of understanding. superficial concepts than actual meaningful ones. Often, Strategic planning is long term and organizational action steps are established from two to five years in the future. communication plays a role in the realization of learning organizations and strategic planning. "Strategy" has many definitions, but it generally involves setting major goals, determining actions to achieve these goals, setting a timeline, and mobilizing resources to execute the actions. Strategy can be planned ("intended") or can be observed as a pattern of activity ("emergent") as the organization adapts to its environment or competes
