Powers of the president of Singapore They should not act as a political centre distinct The powers of the president of Singapore are divided into those which the president may exercise at their own discretion, and those they must exercise in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet of Singapore or of a minister acting under the general authority of the Cabinet. is limited to those matters that, according to the Constitution, they exercises discretionary powers over. In other cases, the president may consult the CPA if they wish to but is not bound to do so. His name is commemorated in the Bernoulli's principle, a particular example of the conservation of energy, which describes the mathematics of the mechanism underlying the operation of two important technologies of the 20th century: the carburetor and the aeroplane wing.
