Northrop Frye has, in his influential *Anatomy of Criticism*, gone so far as to apply the word fiction to any work of art in prose The non-fiction novel is a literary genre that, broadly speaking, depicts non-fictional elements, such as real historical figures and actual events, and uses the storytelling techniques of fiction. Sometimes they incorporate fictitious conversations. The genre is sometimes referred to using the slang term "faction", a portmanteau of the words fact and fiction

Charles Rogers (murder suspect) He remains the only suspect in the murders, which are still considered unsolved. What Charles Frederick Rogers (December 30, 1921 - disappeared June 23, 1965) was an American seismologist, pilot and murder suspect who disappeared in June 1965 after police discovered the dismembered bodies of his elderly parents in the refrigerator of the Houston home all three shared, in what the media later dubbed the "Icebox Murders. Clutter family murders The murders were detailed by Truman Capote in his 1966 non-fiction novel *In Cold Blood*. They were both executed on April 14, 1965. Two ex-convicts, Perry Smith and Richard Hickock, were found guilty of the murders and sentenced to death. Capote, the author of *In Cold Blood* – a non-fiction novel detailing the Clutter family murders – Hickock described his plan as “a cinch, the perfect score” In the early morning of November 15, 1959, four members of the Clutter family – Herb Clutter, his wife, Bonnie, and their teenage children Nancy and Kenyon – were murdered in their rural home just outside the small farming community of Holcomb, Kansas

John D. Voelker His early professional career was as an attorney and county prosecutor in Marquette County. He is best known as the author of the novel *Anatomy of a Murder*, published in 1958. The best-selling novel was turned into an Academy Award-nominated film of the same name—directed by Otto Preminger and starring James Stewart—released on July 1, 1959.
