Typography The term typography is also applied to the style, arrangement, and appearance of the letters, numbers, and symbols created by the process. As the capability to create typography has become ubiquitous, the application of principles and best practices developed over Typography is the art and technique of arranging type to make written language legible, readable and appealing when displayed. The arrangement of type involves selecting typefaces, point sizes, line lengths, line spacing, letter spacing, and spaces between pairs of letters. unrelated designers and lay users. The principles of textual Textual criticism is a branch of textual scholarship, philology, and literary criticism that is concerned with the identification of textual variants, or different versions, of either manuscripts (mss) or of printed books. variation, and because the effort and expense of producing superior editions of his works have always been widely viewed as worthwhile. Historically, scribes who were paid to copy documents may have been literate, but many were simply copyists, mimicking the shapes of letters without necessarily understanding what they meant def2b632b9
