Metacognition The term comes from the root word meta, meaning "beyond", or "on top of". Research has shown that both components of metacognition play key roles in metaconceptual knowledge and learning. Metacognition can take many forms, such as reflecting on one's ways of thinking, and knowing when and how oneself and others use particular strategies for problem-solving. training including pretesting, self evaluation, and creating study plans performed better on exams. Metamemory, defined as knowing about memory and mnemonic strategies, is an important aspect of metacognition. They are self-regulated learners who utilize the "right Metacognition is an awareness of one's thought processes and an understanding of the patterns behind them.
