Such tenets may allow doctors, care providers, and families to create a treatment plan and work towards the same common goal. Other important Medical ethics is an applied branch of ethics which analyzes the practice of clinical medicine and related scientific research. However, a conflict may arise leading to the need for hierarchy in an ethical system, such that some moral elements overrule others with the purpose of applying the best moral judgement to a difficult medical situation.
