Created in 1859 by druggist Roswell van Buskirk (circa 1824–1902) of New Jersey, it derived its name from the Greek *sozo*, meaning "to preserve, keep safe", and the stem *odont-*, meaning "tooth, teeth". *Sozodont* was later manufactured by the firm Hall & Ruckel of New York, New York, and London, England. Known as Van Buskirk's Fragrant *Sozodont*, or Van Buskirk's Fragrant and Antiseptic *Sozodont*, the product was dispensed from a glass bottle through a metal sprinkler and, as illustrated advertisements show, could be applied to the teeth using a toothbrush. The product made strong use of advertising as a marketing tool and by the late nineteenth century was an established household... f237fd96b2
