The concept is used in molecular biology, in cloning, or when subcloning insert DNA into vector DNA. Such ends may be generated by restriction enzymes that break the molecule's phosphodiester backbone at specific locations, which themselves belong to a larger class of enzymes called exonucleases and endonucleases. Partial nominal rigidity occurs when prices can adjust, but less than they would under conditions of perfect flexibility. For example, the price of a good may be contractually set at \$10 per unit for an entire year, regardless of changes in supply and demand conditions. For instance, in a regulated market, there may be legal or institutional limits on how much a price can change within a given year. Complete nominal rigidity occurs when a price remains fixed in nominal terms for a relevant period of time 7690734746
