Doping at the Olympic Games competed at the 2012 Games also tested positive after hundreds of samples were reanalysed. The pursuit of competitive advantage has led athletes to use a variety of banned substances, including anabolic steroids, stimulants, and erythropoietin (EPO), as well as methods like blood doping. Among them are Russia's Aпти Aukhadov (silver at 85 kg), Ukraine's Doping at the Olympic Games refers to the use of prohibited performance-enhancing substances and methods by athletes competing in the Games. High-profile doping scandals have tarnished the reputation of the Olympics and highlighted. Efforts to combat doping have evolved significantly, with the establishment of anti-doping organizations, the development of

sophisticated testing methods, and the implementation of stricter penalties. Throughout the history of the modern Olympics, doping has been a persistent and controversial issue, raising concerns about fair play, athlete health, and the integrity of sport
