Print editions were ended in 2012, but the Britannica continues as an online encyclopedia on the internet. c2db651a98 The Encyclopedia of Yugoslavia comprised eight volumes in its first edition, published between 1955 and 1971. In it he listed 260 species arranged into 51 genera, in turn divided amongst six orders. The entries for each species were very brief; rather than including a description, he gave a citation to an earlier publication — often to his own Fauna suecica, which had been published in 1746. Linnaeus generally followed the classification scheme introduced by the English parson and naturalist John Ray which grouped species based on the characteristics of each species’ bill and feet. c2db651a98
