== Biography == The Grinzane Cavour Prize Association was dissolved on 31 March 2009 as a result of the implication of the organization's president, Giuliano Soria, in an embezzling scheme. Soria used the Grinzane Cavour Prize to gain €4.5 million in government grants which he then appropriated for his personal use. The assets of the organization were acquired by the Monforte d'Alba Bottari Lattes cultural foundation at a bankruptcy auction in 2010. Since 1984, Ramazzotti has released 13 studio albums, one EP, three compilation albums, three live albums, and 37 singles. He has sold over 80 million records in his 40-year career. Throughout his career, Ramazzotti has been recognized with four Italian, Wind & Music Awards, four World Music Awards, three BMI Latin Awards, a Lo Nuestro Awards and a Premios Ondas Career Award.

He was born out of a black aristocratic family, his father being Count Fulvio Filippini Ronconi and his mother Anita Tamagno, tracing back to the Roman patriciate. He grew up in Spain until the Civil War, when his mother was shot by Republicans after which he and his family returned to Italy. By this period he was competent in Italian, Spanish, Catalan, Arabic, Greek and Latin, and later studied several additional languages including Turkish, Hebrew, Chinese, Tibetan, Sanskrit and Persian among others. Due to his wide command of languages, he worked for the Italian radio company EIAR as a foreign news reader. In 1970, the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith ruled that Severino... Lead single "Adesso tu" won the 1986 San Remo Music Festival, and topped the singles charts in Italy, Switzerland and Austria. The version included on the album is 1:05 longer than the single version, with additional instrumental passages. *Nuovi eroi* went on to reach #1 in the same three countries. It is the first of eleven consecutive full-length studio albums by Ramazzotti, up to and including 2009's *Ali e radici*, to top the Italian Albums chart.

Grinzane Cavour Prize The annual award ceremony took place in the medieval castle of Grinzane Cavour. Special prizes for best new author and lifetime achievement were also awarded. The voting system was divided into two phases: first, a jury of literary critics selected finalists, and then they chose an overall winner from the pool of finalists. He died on 15 October 2014 in his home in Luino. Severino's interest for philosophy started thanks to his brother, who had died in the Alpine Corps during the last war, and had been a student at the Normal School in Pisa, having Gentile, Armando Carlini, Luigi Russo, and Calogero as teachers. He attended the Gymnasium and the Liceo classico of Casale Monferrato, and was then educated at the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore of Milan, where he graduated. He later continued his studies in Marburg an der Lahn and Munich. A graduate of the Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore, she studied philosophical feminism with the Diotima group. She proposed a transversal approach that rejects a politics specifically for women that would merely reinforce their subordination to men. Acqui Award of History The prize was founded in 1968 for remembering the victims of the Acqui Military Division who died in Cefalonia (September 13–26, 1943) fighting against the Nazis. A special prize entitled “Witness to the Times,” given to individual personalities known for their cultural contributions and who have distinguished themselves in describing historical events and contemporary society, may also be conferred. The Acqui Award Prize is divided into three sections: history, popular history, and historical novels.
