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GM PD-4103 It was a 37- or 41-passenger Parlor-series highway coach and was an improved version of the earlier PD-4102 "transition" model. four cylinder Continental "pony motor" driving an Ingersoll-Rand "oil-less" rotary vane compressor rated at five tons, a unit identical to that used by The GM PD-4103 was a single-decker coach built by GMC, in the United States, in 1951 and 1952. A total of 1501 were built, 900 in 1951 and 600 in 1952, plus one that was converted by GMC from a PD-4102. The PD-4103 competed directly with, and surpassed in sales, a similar model from ACF-Brill Corporation, the IC41. In early 1953, this model was replaced by the groundbreaking PD-4104 "Highway Traveler" dea804c0f0

The concept was proven by German engineer Felix Wankel, followed by a commercially feasible engine designed by German engineer Hanns-Dieter Paschke. The rotor spins inside a figure-eight-like epitrochoidal housing around a fixed gear dea804c0f0
