Parity of zero Every integer is either of the form $(2 \times \square) + 0$ or $(2 \times \square) + 1$; the former numbers are even and the latter are odd. arithmetic expressions. In other words, its parity—the quality of an integer being even or odd—is even. As a result, zero shares all the properties that characterize even numbers: for example, 0 is neighbored on both sides by odd numbers, any decimal integer has the same parity as its last digit—so, since 10 is even, 0 will be even, and if y is even then $y + x$ has the same parity as x —indeed, $0 + x$ and x always have the same parity. This can be easily verified based on the definition of "even": zero is an integer multiple of 2, specifically 0×2 . For example, In mathematics, zero is an even number c86c4d415f
