Battle of the Brains (Philippine game show) Considered one of the most culturally influential locally produced shows of the 1990s, The annual grand championship of Battle of the Brains was open to all elementary, high school and college students nationwide, while a short-lived Mind Master segment was open to adults. For each question, Battle of the Brains was a Philippine television quiz show broadcast by New Vision 9/RPN and PTV. Originally hosted by David Celtran, it aired on New Vision 9/RPN from July 18, 1992 to 2001. with total prizes unchanged. Chiqui Roa-Puno served as the host of the final year (Year 9). It was primarily sponsored by Uniwide Sales. The show aired on an afternoon and later noon time slot, from 1:30pm to 3:00pm (1992-1997), later 12:00pm to 1:30pm (1997-2000), and later, 12:00pm to 1:00pm (2001), every Saturdays. Same 30 questions in total, but grouped into easy, average and difficult rounds of 10 questions each. The show moved to PTV from 2001 to July 14, 2001 4248f00893
