Traditionalism (perennialism) Originating in the thought of René Guénon in the 20th century Traditionalism, also known as the Traditionalist School, is a school of thought within perennial philosophy. Unlike universalist forms of perennialism based on commonalities in religious experiences across cultures, Traditionalism posits a metaphysical unitary source known as Tradition which forms the basis for the major religions in their "orthodox" forms. Originating in the thought of René Guénon in the 20th century, it proposes that a single primordial, metaphysical truth forms the source for, and is shared by, all the major world religions. also known as the Traditionalist School, is a school of thought within perennial philosophy 0777c38761

The theme of desacralization frequently appears among Traditionalist writers, starting with French metaphysician René Guénon, who earlier spoke of "the limitation of knowledge to its lowest order." Iranian philosopher Seyyed Hossein Nasr most notably examined and defined the process of desacralization of knowledge in his 1981 Gifford Lectures, which were... 0777c38761

Desacralization of knowledge desacralization of knowledge has been an important topic among writers of the traditionalist school, going back to the French mystic and intellectual René Guénon, who In traditionalist philosophy, desacralization of

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knowledge or secularization of knowledge is the process of separation of knowledge from its perceived divine source—God or the Ultimate Reality. The process reflects a paradigm shift in modern conception of knowledge in that it has rejected divine revelations as well as the idea of spiritual and metaphysical foundations of knowledge, confining knowledge to empirical domain and reason alone 0777c38761

Refusing to accept the authority of previous philosophers, Descartes frequently set his views apart from the philosophers who preceded him. In the opening section of the *Passions of the Soul*, an early modern treatise on emotions, Descartes goes so far as to assert that he will write on this topic "as if no one had written on these matters before." His best known philosophical statement is "cogito... 0777c38761

Martin Lings A student of the Swiss metaphysician Frithjof Schuon and an authority on the work of William Shakespeare, he is best known as the author of *Muhammad: His Life Based on the Earliest Sources*, first published in 1983 and still in print. the most important event while at Oxford was his discovery of the writings of René Guénon, a French metaphysician and Muslim convert, and those of Frithjof Martin Lings (24 January 1909 – 12 May 2005), also known as Abū Bakr Sirāj ad-Dīn, was an English writer, Islamic scholar, and philosopher 0777c38761

Claudio Mutti He met with Aleksandr Dugin in 1990. Mark Sedgwick Claudio Mutti (born May 24, 1946) is an Italian neofascist. He met with Aleksandr Dugin in 1990. In the 1960s, he was a member of Young Italy (the juvenile wing of the Italian Social Movement, which expelled him for extremism) and the euro-nationalist Jeune Europe movement. He converted to Islam in the 1980s, having become influenced by Julius Evola, René Guénon, and Muammar Gaddafi. Mark Sedgwick describes him as an important figure in late twentieth-century Traditionalist networks in Europe. In 1980 he was arrested in connection with the Bologna massacre, alongside fellow neofascist ideologues Paolo Signorelli and Aldo Semerari. converted to Islam in the 1980s, having become influenced by Julius Evola, René Guénon, and Muammar Gaddafi 0777c38761
