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Edward Teller He had a volatile personality, and was "driven by his megaton ambitions, had a messianic complex, and displayed autocratic behavior. analyzed his problems using basic principles of physics and often discussed with his cohorts to make headway through difficult problems. " He devised a thermonuclear Alarm Clock bomb with a yield of 1000 MT (1 GT of TNT) and proposed delivering it by boat or submarine to incinerate a continent. This was seen when Edward Teller (Hungarian: Teller Ede; January 15, 1908 - September 9, 2003) was a Hungarian-American theoretical physicist and chemical engineer who is known colloquially as "the father of the hydrogen bomb" and one of the creators of the Teller-Ulam design inspired by Stanisław Ulam 2e5c3b0837
