Horror comics The single-issue Harvey Comics anthologies Front Page Horror comics are comic books, graphic novels, black-and-white comics magazines, and manga focusing on horror fiction. Black-and-white horror-comics magazines, which did not fall under the Code, flourished from the mid-1960s through the early 1980s from a variety of publishers.
