IBIS was invented by Werner Kunz and Horst Rittel in the 1960s.

According to Kunz and Rittel, "Issue-Based Information Systems (IBIS) are meant to support coordination and planning of political decision processes. IBIS guides the identification, structuring, and settling of issues raised by problem-solving groups, and provides information pertinent to the discourse." a1c93bc147 It was independently proposed by Tōsaku Mizuhashi (水橋 俊作) in 1937, and by Amiel R.
