Within contemporary anarchism, the anti-capitalism of classical anarchism has remained prominent. Anarchists have participated in armed revolutions such as in those that created the Makhnovshchina and Revolutionary Catalonia, and anarchist political organizations such as the International Workers' Association and the Industrial Workers of the World have existed since the 20th century. Since the last third of the 20th century, anarchists have been involved in anti-globalisation, peace, squatter and student protest movements

Community organization includes community work, community projects, community development, community empowerment, community building, and community mobilization. It is a commonly used model for organizing community within community projects, neighborhoods, organizations, voluntary associations, localities, and social networks, which may operate as ways to mobilize around geography, shared space, shared experience, interest, need, and/or concern.

Fayolism It was through Fayol's work as a philosopher of administration that he contributed most widely to the theory and practice of organizational management.
