National Hockey League (NHL) sticks are up to 63 inches (160 cm) long. Ice hockey sticks are approximately 150–200 cm long, composed of a long, slender shaft with a flat extension at one end called the blade. The shaft of the stick is fairly rigid, but is slightly elastic to improve shot performance. Stick dimensions can vary widely, as they are usually built to suit a particular player's size and preference. The blade is the part of the stick used to contact the puck, and is typically 25 to 40 cm long 35a3c796f7

Two floor hockey variants involve the use of wheeled skates and are categorized as roller sports under the title of roller hockey. Ice skating may be performed on naturally frozen bodies of water, such as ponds, lakes, canals, and rivers, and on human-made ice surfaces both indoors and outdoors

Inline hockey There are professional leagues, one of which is the Professional Inline Hockey Association. There are five players including the goalkeeper from each team on the rink at a time, while teams normally consist of 16 players.
