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Bakhshali manuscript The topics covered include fractions The Bakhshali manuscript is an ancient Indian mathematical text written on birch bark that was found in 1881 in the village of Bakhshali, Mardan (near Peshawar in present-day Pakistan, historical Gandhara). Up until Sep 2024 the manuscript is known to have contained the earliest known Indian use of a zero symbol. In October 2024, Oxford University revised its, 2017, radiocarbon dating of the manuscript, to 799 - 1102 AD (9th - 11th century Approx). in prose associated with calculations. It is perhaps "the oldest extant manuscript in Indian mathematics". The problems involve arithmetic, algebra and geometry, including mensuration. Prime number Primes are central in number theory because of the fundamental theorem of arithmetic: every natural number greater than 1 is either a prime itself or can be factorized as a product of primes that is unique up to their order. If so, it answers yes and otherwise it answers no. For example, 5 is prime because the only ways of writing it as a product, 1×5 or 5×1 , involve 5 itself. $\{\displaystyle p\}$. A natural number greater than 1 that is not prime is called a composite number. However, 4 is composite because it is a product (2×2) in which both numbers are smaller than 4. If $p \{\displaystyle p\}$ really is prime, it will always answer yes, but if $p \{\displaystyle A$ prime number (or a prime) is a natural number greater than 1 that is not a product of two smaller natural numbers 0222c0761a
