objects. An RFID system consists of a tiny radio transponder called a tag, a radio receiver, and a transmitter. This number can be used to track inventory goods. When triggered by an electromagnetic interrogation pulse from a nearby RFID reader device, the tag transmits digital data, usually an identifying inventory number, back to the reader.
