Some creosote types were used historically as a treatment for components of seagoing and outdoor wood structures to prevent rot (e.g., bridgework and railroad ties, see image). Samples may be found commonly inside chimney flues, where the coal or wood burns under variable conditions, producing soot and tarry smoke. Creosotes are the principal chemicals responsible for the stability, scent, and flavor characteristic of smoked meat; the name is derived from Greek κρέας (kreas) 'meat' and σωτήρ (sōtēr) 'preserver'. 95be347c14

Biogenic substance active compounds. While the term originally

was specific to metabolite compounds that had toxic effects on other organisms, it has developed to encompass any constituents, secretions, and metabolites of plants or animals. In context of molecular biology, biogenic substances are referred to as biomolecules. They are generally isolated and measured through the use of chromatography and mass spectrometry techniques. Additionally, the transformation and exchange of biogenic substances can be modelled in the environment, particularly their transport in waterways. The professional practice is becoming more clinically oriented as most of the drugs are now manufactured by pharmaceutical industries. It is a miscellaneous science as it links health sciences with pharmaceutical sciences and natural sciences. Based on the setting, pharmacy practice is either classified as community or institutional pharmacy 95be347c14

Partition coefficient This ratio is therefore a comparison of the solubilities of the solute in these two liquids. The partition coefficient generally refers to the concentration ratio of un-ionized species of compound, whereas the distribution coefficient refers to the concentration ratio of all species of the compound (ionized plus un-ionized). concentration ratio of all species of the compound (ionized plus un-ionized). Prodrugs are often designed to improve bioavailability when a drug itself is poorly absorbed from the gastrointestinal tract. A prodrug may be used to improve how selectively the drug interacts with cells or processes that are not its intended target. This reduces adverse or unintended effects of a drug, especially important in treatments like chemotherapy, which can have severe unintended and undesirable side effects. 95be347c14 Biochemists also research how certain chemical reactions happen in cells and tissues and observe and record the effects of products in food additives and medicines. 95be347c14
