Marine pollution discharged in the course of the mining can cause problems, such as copper, a common industrial pollutant, which can interfere with the life history and Marine pollution occurs when substances used or spread by humans, such as industrial, agricultural, and residential waste; particles; noise or light; excess carbon dioxide; or invasive organisms enter the ocean and cause harmful effects there. It is a combination of chemicals and trash, most of which comes from land sources and is washed or blown into the ocean. These nonpoint sources are largely due to

runoff that enters the ocean through rivers, but wind-blown debris and dust can also play a role, as these pollutants can settle into waterways. This pollution results in damage to the environment, to the health of all organisms, and to economic structures worldwide. The majority of this waste (80%) comes from land-based activity, although marine transportation significantly contributes as well. Air pollution is also a contributing factor, as it carries iron, carbonic acid, nitrogen, silicon, sulfur, pesticides, and dust particles into the ocean. Since most inputs come from land, via rivers, sewage, or the atmosphere, it means that continental shelves are more vulnerable to pollution. The pollution often comes from nonpoint sources such as agricultural runoff, wind-blown debris, and dust
