Definitions of accounting terms, accounting concepts, account equations, account derivation principles and standard accounting procedures. The first international standard was published in 1953. The pre-edit version for the SNA 2025 revision was adopted by the United Nations Statistical Commission at its 56th Session in March 2025. Behind the accounts system, there is also a system of people: the people who are cooperating around the world to produce the statistics, for use by government agencies, businesspeople, media, academics and interest groups from all nations 196d5e906b
