Compare-and-swap It compares the contents of a In computer science, compare-and-swap (CAS) is an atomic instruction used in multithreading to achieve synchronization. The atomicity guarantees that the new value is calculated based on up-to-date information; if the value had been updated by another thread in the meantime, the write would fail. This is done as a single atomic operation. It compares the contents of a memory location with a given (the previous) value and, only if they are the same, modifies the contents of that memory location to a new given value. In computer science, compare-and-swap (CAS) is an atomic instruction used in multithreading to achieve synchronization. The result of the operation must indicate whether it performed the substitution; this can be done either with a simple boolean response (this variant is often called compare-and-set), or by returning the value read from the memory location (not the value written to it), thus "swapping 990ec3ba34
