Larger satellites usually use monopropellants or bipropellant combustion systems for propulsion and attitude control; these systems are complex A small satellite, miniaturized satellite, or smallsat is a satellite of low mass and size, usually under 1,200 kg (2,600 lb). Miniature satellites, especially in large numbers, may be more useful than fewer, larger ones for some purposes - for example, gathering of scientific data and radio relay. While all such satellites can be referred to as "small", different classifications are used to categorize them based on mass. Stuxnet Stuxnet targets supervisory control and data acquisition (SCADA) systems and is believed to be responsible for causing substantial damage to the Iran nuclear program after it was first installed on a computer at the Natanz Nuclear Facility in 2009. While it is not the first time that hackers have targeted industrial systems, nor the first Stuxnet is a malicious computer worm first uncovered on June 17, 2010, and thought to have been in development since at least 2005.
