

Philip Pullman

The first book, *La Belle Sauvage*, was published in October 2017, and is set 12 years before *Northern Lights*. It describes how the 11-year-old Malcolm Polstead and the 15-year-old Alice protect the infant Lyra; leading to her being in the care of Jordan College. It introduces the research by academics and other free-thinkers into Dust, a mysterious subatomic particle related to consciousness, and the origins of Lyra's alethiometer.

Philip Randolph, Pullman porters formed the first all-black union, the Brotherhood of Sleeping Pullman porters were men hired to work for the railroads as porters on sleeping cars. The term "porter" has been superseded in modern American usage by "sleeping car attendant", with the former. Under the leadership of A.
