Heating, ventilation, and air conditioning Zones are controlled by multiple thermostats. HVAC system design is a subdiscipline of mechanical engineering, based on the principles of thermodynamics, fluid mechanics, and heat transfer. In water heating systems the thermostats control zone valves, and in forced air systems they control zone dampers Heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) is the use of various technologies to control the temperature, humidity, and purity of the air in an enclosed space.

"Refrigeration" is sometimes added to the field's abbreviation as HVAC&R or HVACR, or "ventilation" is dropped, as in HACR (as in the designation of HACR-rated circuit breakers). Its goal is to provide thermal comfort and acceptable indoor air quality

Cave-diving is underwater diving in water-filled caves. A distinction is made by recreational diver training agencies between cave-diving and cavern. considerable distance along a complex route from the nearest open air. It may be done as an extreme sport, a way of exploring flooded caves for scientific investigation, or for the search for and recovery of divers or, as in the 2018 Thai cave rescue, other cave users. The equipment used varies depending on the circumstances, and ranges from breath hold to surface supplied, but almost all cave-diving is done using scuba equipment, often in specialised configurations with redundancies such as sidemount or backmounted twinset. Recreational cave-diving is generally considered to be a type of technical diving due to the lack of a free surface during large parts of the dive, and often involves planned decompression

Air conditioning [citation needed] This compressor uses two interleaving scrolls to compress Air conditioning, often abbreviated as A/C (US) or air con (UK), is the process of removing heat from an enclosed space to achieve a more comfortable interior temperature and, in some cases, controlling the humidity of internal air. Air conditioning is a member of a family of systems and techniques that provide heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC). crankcase, crankshaft, piston rod, piston, piston ring, cylinder head and valves. Heat pumps are similar in many ways to air conditioners but use a reversing valve, allowing them to both heat and cool an enclosed space. Air conditioning can be achieved using a mechanical 'air conditioner' or through other methods, such as passive cooling and ventilative cooling 6e1cff1355

Diving rebreather The gas supply at the diver was controlled by two valves. This differs from open-circuit breathing apparatus, where the exhaled gas

is discharged directly into the environment. valve was fitted to reduce the risk of flooding the scrubber. The purpose is to extend the breathing endurance of a limited gas supply, and, for covert military use by frogmen or observation of underwater life, to eliminate the bubbles produced by an open circuit system. The "Hoke valve" controlled flow A diving rebreather is an underwater breathing apparatus that absorbs the carbon dioxide of a diver's exhaled breath to permit the rebreathing (recycling) of the substantially unused oxygen content, and unused inert content when present, of each breath.
