Washington Assessment of Student Learning Fifth and eighth graders were tested in reading, math and science. The WASL was also used as a high school graduation examination beginning in the spring of 2006 and ending in 2009. tested in reading and math; fourth and seventh graders in math, reading and writing. The The Washington Assessment of Student Learning (WASL) was a standardized educational assessment system given as the primary assessment in the state of Washington from spring 1997 to summer 2009. It was given to students from third through eighth grades and tenth grade. It has been replaced by the High School Proficiency Exam (HSPE), the Measurements of Students Progress (MSP) for grades 3–8, and later the Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBAC). Third and sixth graders were tested. The WASL assessment consisted of examinations over four subjects (reading, mathematics, science, and writing) with four different types of questions (multiple-choice, short-answer, essay, and problem solving) f90b4c00c6
