However, 4 is composite because it is a product (2×2) in which both numbers are smaller than 4. The prime ideals of the A prime number (or a prime) is a natural number greater

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than 1 that is not a product of two smaller natural numbers. prime ideal, are an important tool and object of study in commutative algebra, algebraic number theory and algebraic geometry.
