As of 2015, 8 million Transit vans have been sold, making it the third best-selling van of all time and has been produced across four basic platform generations (debuting in 1965, 1986, 2000, and 2013 respectively), with various "facelift" versions of each. The vehicle is also known as the Ford T-Series (T-150, T-250, T-350), a nomenclature shared with Ford's other light commercial vehicles, the Ford F-Series trucks, and the Ford E-Series chassis ecdc2965f3

The mechanical changes and upgrades were done during production of the vehicles. The AA usually received plainer interiors than their car counterparts. Ford, except it was substantially larger and heavier to accommodate the work this truck was designed for. Body design and style was developed and then outsourced to various body manufacturers, including Briggs and Murray. The Model AA followed similar design changes to the Model A during the AA's four years in production, often delayed anywhere from three to nine months. As the Model T and TT became obsolete and needed to be replaced, Henry Ford began initial designs on the Model A and Model AA in 1926. The designs of the Model A shared parts and materials with the Model AA Ford, notably the body, engine and interior ecdc2965f3
