The human skeleton can be divided into the axial skeleton and the appendicular skeleton. Earlier editions were called *Anatomy: Descriptive and Surgical*, *Anatomy of the Human Body* and *Gray's Anatomy: Descriptive and Applied*, but the book's name is commonly shortened to, and later editions are titled, *Gray's Anatomy*. 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abdomen), genitals, arms, hands, legs, and feet. The internal human body includes organs, teeth, bones, muscle, tendons, ligaments, blood vessels and blood, lymphatic vessels and lymph.
