Freedom of information Michael Buckland defines six types of barriers that have to be overcome in order for access to information to be achieved: identification of Freedom of information is freedom of a person or people to publish and have access to information. Article 19 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights provides for the right to "receive and impart information and ideas through any media and regardless of frontiers", while access to information encompasses the ability of an individual to seek, receive and impart information effectively.
