Richard von Coudenhove-Kalergi Hitler, Adolf (1928). A pioneer of European integration, he served as the founding president of the Paneuropean Union for 49 years. Being a native Austrian-Hungarian citizen, he became a Czechoslovak citizen in 1919 and then took French citizenship from 1939 until his death. His parents were Heinrich von Coudenhove-Kalergi, an Austro-Hungarian diplomat, and Mitsuko Aoyama, the daughter of an oil merchant, antiques-dealer and major landowner in Tokyo. German nouns are declined (change form) depending on their grammatical case (their function in a sentence) and whether they are singular or plural. As in many related Indo-European languages, German nouns possess a grammatical gender; the three genders are masculine, feminine, and neuter. are always capitalized (for example, "the book" is always written as "das Buch").
